JOINT KNOWLEDGE ONLINE

Joint Knowledge Online (JKO) / Advanced Distributed Learning (ADL) Mobile is a collaborative effort to deliver a free mobile Application (App) that provides access to unclassified, releasable, mobile training and performance aiding content using Apple and Android mobile phones and tablets. The JKO Mobile App is available in Apple and Android App stores, for use on Apple and Android tablets and phones.

The JKO/ADL mobile capability is enabled by:

- JKO Mobile App used to download mobile content.
- Mobile Learning Suite (m-LS) that manages all mobile content, mobile user information, and synchronization of information between the JKO Mobile App and the m-LS.

How to Get Started:

1. **Obtain your Personal Identification Number (PIN).** Your PIN controls access to the m-LS. Submit request for PIN access to the m-LS to JADLadmin@act.nato.int.
2. **Download and Install the JKO Mobile App** from your Apple or Android app store, type in your PIN and download available courses from the App's "Library" section.
3. **Complete training courses on your mobile device.** Course completion records are sent to the m-LS server upon a successful "Sync" with your device ("Sync" requires connection via Wi-Fi or a mobile data plan). Your mobile course completion records are stored and available for transcript reporting from the m-LS server.



The JKO Mobile App can be downloaded to an Apple iPad, iPod, and iPhone as well as an Android tablet and phone.

With JKO Mobile you can:

- Complete courses
- Access NATO specific content
- Access Partnership Lab specific content

JKO Mobile is a training capability delivered by the JKO/ADL Mobile Pilot Program - a collaboration between JKO and ADL Initiative's Partnership Labs to access training and education using mobile devices.
